## **More Information about the Teaching Consultant Role**

Goldsmiths, University of London recruits a number of social workers every year from Lewisham Council, Southwark Council and the Royal Borough of Greenwich to teach social work students.

Social workers who teach students are called teaching consultants.

You could teach social work students in different ways

- Co-teach a session with a lecturer
- Facilitate or co-facilitate a workshop
- Co-facilitate a reflective practice student supervision group
- Teach on a study unit (e.g. assessment, risk assessment in adult social care and mental health; partnership and long-term planning, child protection, multidisciplinary work)

In the application form, you will have an opportunity to tell us what areas of social work practice you might be interested in teaching.

In early May we will 'match' applicants and their teaching interests to the curriculum needs of our social work programmes.

We will then be in touch to let you know the outcome of the matching process and hopefully let you know what you could be teaching in academic year 2019/2020.

Above all, we are looking for teaching consultants who can empathise with students and want to share their experience, enthusiasm and knowledge about social work.
